Free-Riding Zone

◆ The Big Bowl / Higashi Shamen Area

The iconic huge off-piste area of Arai, a short 30-Minute hike to the summit brings you to the best powder we have to offer. Snow shoes and other hiking equipments are highly recommended.

Groomed Course

A groomed course running across the bottom part of the Big Bowl and Higashi Shamen, ending at top of the Kokenashi Lift station. (Includes a short black run)

Free-Riding Zone

◆◆ Wase Area

An expansive area surrounded by the Exciter and MamushiGaeshi course. Plan out your lines ahead whilst going up on the Kokenashi Lift.

◆◆ Mamushi Area

A free riding area for only the best of the best riders.
Bowls, ridges, trees, cliffs, Mamushi has it all.

Free-Riding Zone

Amazing tree runs with bumps and jumps along the way.
Scout your lines when going up the Sanroku 2nd lift.

◆ **Discovery**

A hidden free-riding course at the top of the KG Area.

■ Umanose ● Sunrise

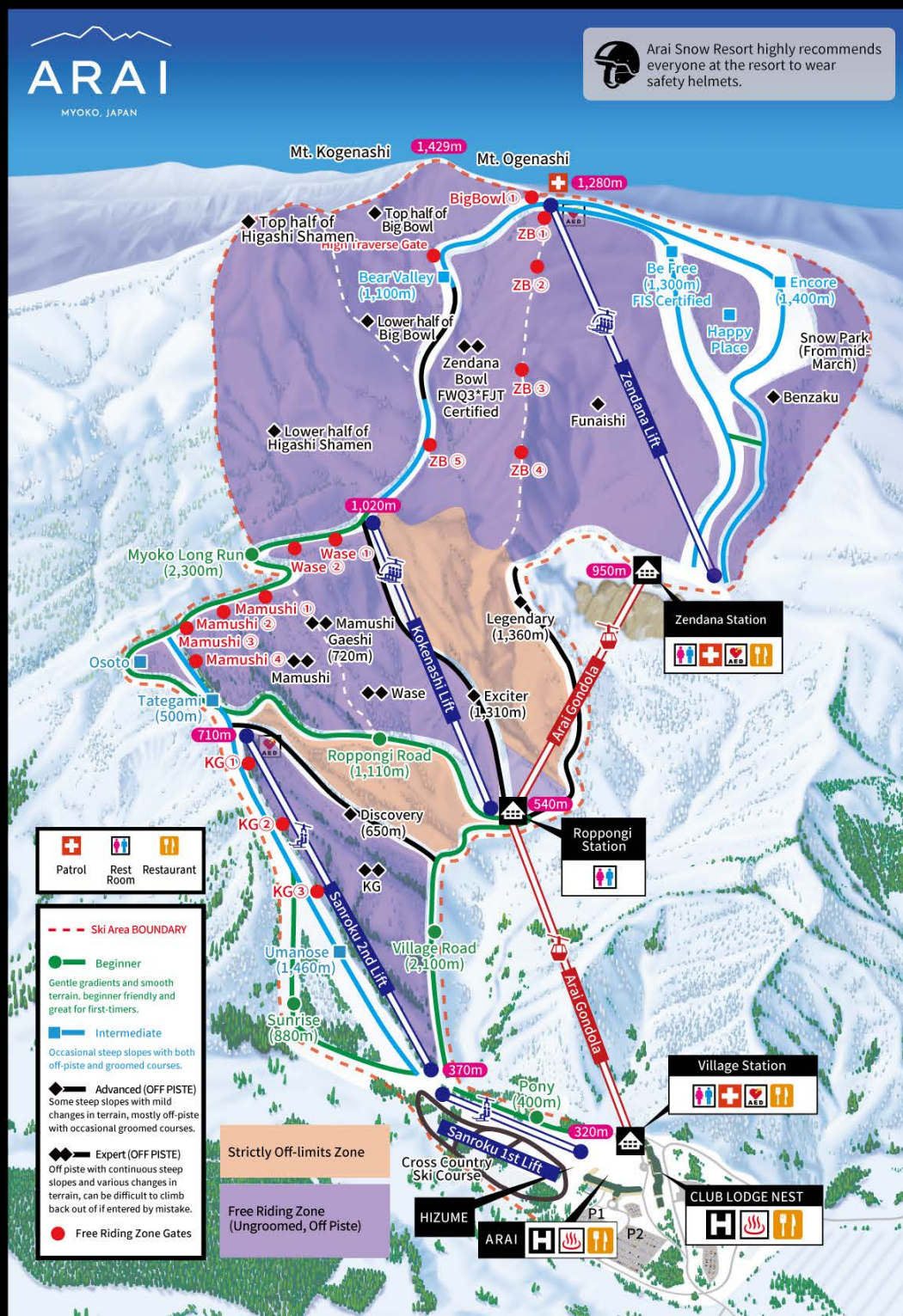
The main groomed courses of the Sanroku Area.

Groomed Course

Where the LOTTE Arai FIS Cup is held on. FIS Certified and accessible from both the Funaishi and Happy Place Area.

Groomed Course

One of our wider courses, suitable for long carved turns. The Snow park is built here post march.

■ Happy Place

Fit for first-timers on powder, with trees and gentle slopes. Mogul courses are set up during spring.

◆Funaishi

One of the consistently open zones during winter. Starting off with short tree runs and opening up to big open runs near the end.

◆◆Zendana Bowl

Home to the steepest terrains at Arai.

Beginner courses

The beginner course, perfect for first-timers.

●Myoko long run, Roppongi Road

The longest runs of the resort, winding down from Kokenashi to Roppongi Station.
